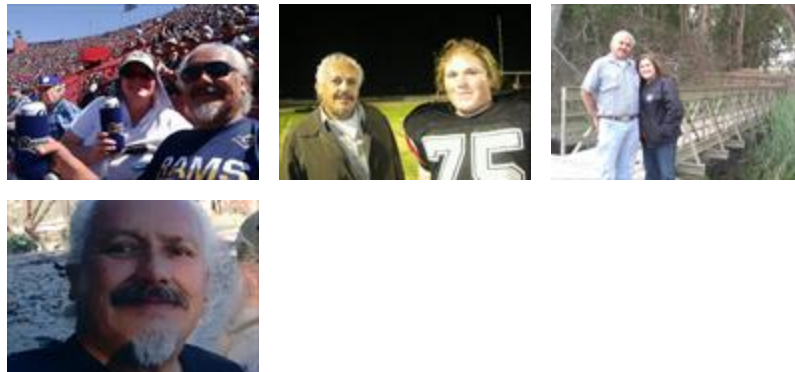
and our community. Fred never past up an opportunity to re-use anything, making something new for another to enjoy.
