Louise Kemak a resident of Cambria for 46 years passed away peacefully at her home on July 4, 2017. Louise was born in Vernon, Alabama on February 6, 1923, she was the daughter of George and Eunice Loftis. Raised on a farm during the depression, Louise had a real appreciation for the simple things. She is remembered for her southern charm, big hugs, and devotion to her family and kindness to all.

During WWII she was a Rosie the Reveler in Florida where she met John, her husband of 72 years. John was responsible for getting airplane parts to Louise's department and kept on volunteering to bring parts over until he won the heart of the blue eyed beauty.

They settled in Cambria in 1971 with their 3 children where they owned and operated the Sea Shore Motel on Moonstone Beach Drive. Louise was active in the Chamber of Commerce helping to promote businesses. In 1978 they built a home on Happy Hill where they lived until her passing.

Never one to be idle she opened Nimble Fingers where she combined her sewing skills with her love of people. She helped hundreds of locals with their alterations.

She was an active parishioner at Santa Rosa Catholic Church. She loved music and singing and was the Music Director at Santa Rosa Catholic Church for many years. She was also in the local Choral Choir.

She is survived by her husband John Kemak, sons John and Michael Kemak of Cambria, and daughter Anya deLancellotti and husband David deLancellotti

of Santa Ana, grand children Megan Straub, Luca deLancellotti, Paolo deLancellotti, Natasha Kemak and Justin Kemak.
