Her parents owned two markets in SLO, Pioneer Market and Laurel Lane Market, for which she helped distribute weekly ads. Later in life, she worked as an Instructional Aide for San Luis Coastal Unified School District for over 20 years, which she found very fulfilling. Beverly had a strong Catholic faith, which she instilled in her family. She also instilled her faith in others by teaching Catechism at St Timothy's Church in Morro Bay, where she seldom missed a Sunday Mass.

In 1968, while peeking out the window of her family's Broad street home, Beverly caught the eye of a special someone, which sparked a love story that developed into 54 wonderful married years. In 1970, she married that special someone, and she and Albert spent their lives together raising their three children and embarking on many adventures including trips to the snow, camping, fishing, and rafting. Beverly's true passion in life was always her family, especially her six grandchildren, whom she loved dearly. Affectionately known as Ava, she was always there with a home cooked meal, a storybook, a smile, a joke, or much needed advice. She seldom missed an event if one of her grandchildren were involved.
