Dorothy Treanor passed away on Saturday, January 20, 2018 at the age of 98. Born November 22, 1919 to Agnes and Peter Meyers of Avila Beach, Dorothy was a lifelong resident of San Luis Obispo County. She graduated from Arroyo Grande High School in 1937.
