



Gerard Francis Gentilucci

September 10, 1928 - January 18, 2017

Born September 10, 1928 he was raised a first generation American Italian in Brighton, Mass. Gerry married his high school sweetheart Margaret DeStefano on October 2, 1948 and raised two children: Gerard Anthony and Karen Marie. He and his wife (affectionately known as Chickie) were married 68 years.

Gerry moved the family to Southern California in 1958 where he applied his skills as a “finish carpenter”. Soon after he was hired with the Pasadena City School District, where those skills were well applied. Eventually he progressed into supervisory positions directing the personnel necessary to keep 40 different high schools functioning.

In the 1960s, his East Coast love of great seafood and adventures, Gerry and the family discovered the central coast where he found open spaces and satisfied his love of seafood, specially clams and abalone. Able to obtain a summer residence in Shell Beach, he and the family enjoyed the best of all worlds: picking up giant clams just walking Pismo, and Abalone off the shoals of Shell Beach. So it was no surprise when he landed employment at Cal Poly, SLO achieving his life long dream of the Central Coast life. His offspring have taken root as well.

Retiring after 17 years at Cal Poly as a Building Trades Supervisor, he now had lots of time (25 years as it turns out), to take it all in. Gerry and his wife Margaret spent lots of time (20 years) in Kauai and Tahoe.

Gerry is survived by his wife, his two children, his two grand children and two

great-grand children.
