Luis Gomes Santos, age 82, passed away peacefully on January 1, 2022 in San Luis Obispo, CA.

Luis was born in 1939 on the island of Faial, Azores. He migrated to California at 18 years old and worked on an uncle's dairy in the San Joaquin Valley before moving to San Jose, California where he worked construction and met his wife of 60 years. Shortly thereafter, he moved to San Luis Obispo where working construction he helped to build Cuesta College and the reactors at Diablo Canyon among many other local projects. He later started his own Concrete construction business and his "Santos Concrete" stamp can still be seen on sidewalks and driveways in and around the city. After retiring from construction Luis worked as the groundskeeper at Mission San Luis Obispo for 25 years. He was very proud of keeping the gardens and interior of the Mission in beautiful condition for the many visitors that toured throughout.

He enjoyed traveling, farming, being a grandfather and looked forward to visiting his native island annually. Luis is survived by his wife Marianne Santos, son Rick Santos, Two grandchildren, and five siblings. A Rosary will be held Wednesday evening January 5th at Reis mortuary at 6p. A funeral at Mission San Luis Obispo will follow on Thursday the 6th at 10am.
