Bill Endert was born in San Jose, California on June 4, 1939 to William Endert and Helen Margaret (Foley) Endert. He attended school there participating in track and field events with his high school team. Upon graduation from Willow Glen High School and attending San Jose City College, Bill pursued a pharmacy degree at the University of Arizona in Tucson and became a registered pharmacist. He worked mostly in retail pharmacies early in his career: Tenth St. Drug in San Jose, California, and Rite Aid and Grover Drug here on the Central Coast. Much of his career was spent at General Hospital in San Luis Obispo.

In addition to coaching his sons in soccer and distance running, Bill had many hobbies and interests.
